

DEER RESISTANT ~ Perennials

The following is a list of plants that have been shown to be resistant, either by vigorous growth to recover from browsing or by unfavorable taste or texture. Deer cannot read, though, so a shortage of forage food can cause deer to devour almost any plants including the ones generally known to be deer resistant.
