

DORMANT SPRAY SCHEDULE

Due to Oregon's wet weather, the use of a spreader sticker will assure better results when spraying. Read product labels to determine best days of use.

Copper Spray: An organic fungicide for disease control while the plant still has its foliage.

Dormant Spray: An organic insecticide for control of most insects, their eggs & mites.

Lime Sulphur: An organic fungicide for control of certain diseases.
